

Message of the President of the Italian National Council of Actuaries

Dear participants in the 14th Italian National Congress of Actuaries,

a warm welcome to this important event that attracts a large part of our profession and involves many stakeholders, politicians, institutions, press, supervisory authorities, public and private bodies, associations, professional associations, the financial, insurance, social security and corporate world, as well as the European and international actuarial world. There are just over 1,160 registered members in Italy, in constant and continuous growth; the Actuary has now taken on a visibility that can also be seen with this Congress.
